## Creation of Sustainable Job Opportunities for Women Workers in Indecent Work Environment

Name of the Ministry or Institution	Ministry of Labor
Project Objectives	The program aims to integrate unemployed women and women workers in indecent work environment to work in the local market, to empower them economically, and to find decent job opportunities.
Project Description	<p>Through this program, efforts will be made to reduce women's employment in indecent working conditions by finding decent alternative and sustainable job opportunities, and by encouraging them to work in the local market.</p> <p>A number of employment and empowerment strategies will be adopted, including strengthening their ability to establish individual and group income-generating businesses through supporting their technical capabilities, providing them with appropriate financing, encouraging them to work within cooperatives, especially in the agricultural sector, in addition to integrating them directly, providing them with paid job opportunities or paid training in specific specializations that suit the needs of the market, and empowering them. The program will take into account enhancing the social empowerment services provided by the specialized institutions, led by the Ministry of Women Affairs and the Ministry of Social Development.</p> <p>The program will provide approximately 6,000 job opportunities within three years, and will establish 1,000 family home-based businesses, establish 2,000 individual and groups small businesses, in addition to support the establishment of a number of cooperatives.</p>
