Project Objectives	The government has recently decided to establish a national distinguished TVET university model namely Nablus University for Vocational and Technical Education (NU-VTE) that provides career focused education and training in vocational and technical programs to capitalize on skilled human resources of Palestine. One of the main and mile-stone university colleges is going to be College of Telecommunication and Information Technology. Here, we propose to establish a new modern and an-environmentally friendly building for this crucial college.
Project Description	This college is proposed to offer eight professional (one year), intermediate applied (two years) and bachelor programs (four years) including - computer programming, - cyber-Security, - game design and simulation designer, - live entertainment technology, - web designer and developer, - visual communication-3D animation, - digital photography and graphic design, and - mobile/web application development program. The college seeks to hold around 1400 students as a full capacity distributed among the intended programs.
