

Increase Access to The Labor Market for Youth Job Seekers Through Business and Vocational Training (Ayadi)

Name of the Ministry or Institution	The Palestinian Employment Fund and Ministry of Labor
Project Objectives	The program aims to increase access to the labor market for young job seekers, through continuing technical vocational education and training in the workplace in order to have a better job opportunity.
Project Description	The program uses a significant approach as Work-Based learning which is "a good example of a winning situation, it should be viewed by all the parties as an investment, and notably when the learning occurs in a company, as with continuous vocational education and training "CVET" courses and apprenticeships. There are benefits from this approach of learning for all parties and stakeholders involved, beginning with the learner and the employer who hosts the learner and /or cooperates with the TVET provider (school/institution), through TVET providers themselves to the learner family and up to the broader level of society."
